DESIGNATING YOUR PROPERTY TAXES

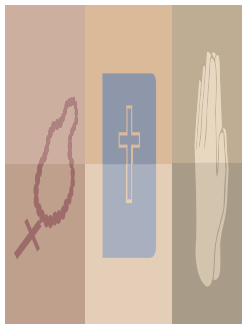
It's property tax assessment time. How do you make sure that your tax bill reflects your support of publicly funded Catholic schools? The Alberta Catholic School Trustees Association has released a school tax brochure that contains all of the information you need to know when it comes to declaring support of the Catholic separate school district in your municipality.

It is important for Catholic ratepayers, even if your kids are older and out of school, to designate your property taxes appropriately for Catholic separate schools for the purposes of school board tax support and municipal elections.
