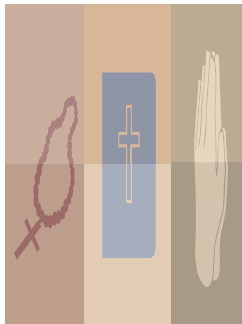

**CATHOLIC ANSWERS TO CATHOLIC QUESTIONS**

**Q.** 1. How soon should a Catholic Baby be baptized?

**A.** 1. Regarding the baptism of infants (babies), the Canon Law of the Catholic Church States:

Can. 867 § 1 Parents are obliged to see that their infants are baptized within the first few weeks. As soon as possible after the birth, indeed even before it, they are to approach the parish priest to ask for the sacrament for their child, and to be themselves duly prepared for it.

§ 2 If the infant is in danger of death, it is to be baptized without any delay.

It should be noted that many priests will no longer baptize infants/children unless the parents have participated in the baptism preparation program. Therefore, as soon as the mother knows that she is pregnant, she and her husband should contact the local parish to sign up for the next program that will be offered.

A parent should never risk delaying the baptism of their God given gift, a child, a soul. Many parents are tormented by the fact that they never thought their baby would suddenly die from SID (Sudden Infant Death), unexpected illness, birth defects, etc... There is no reason to delay the baptism of a baby for weeks or months.
