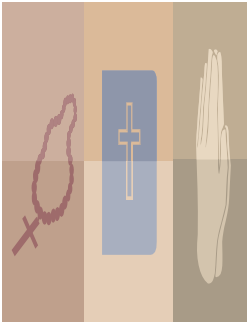
WESTERN CANADA LITURGY CONFERENCE 2016
